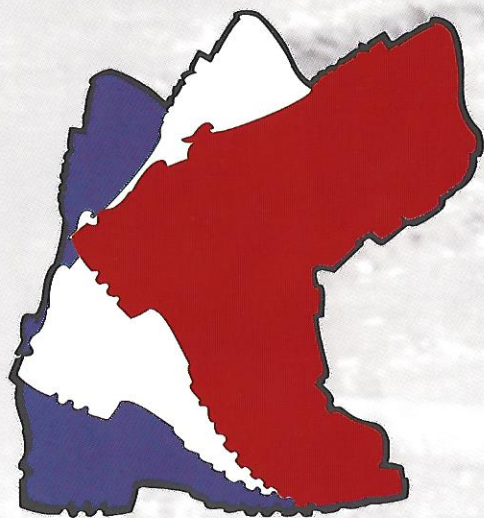

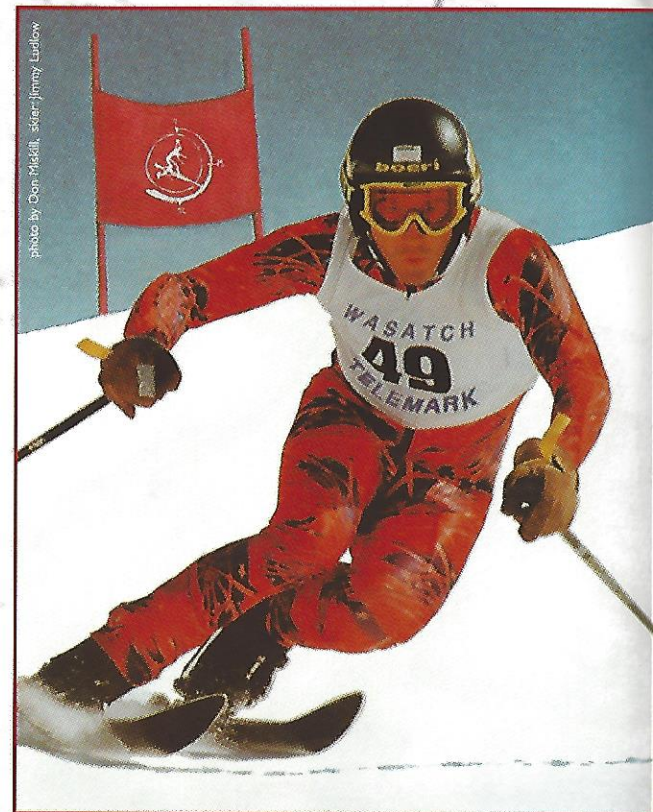
The Masters World Championships will be awarded based on combined point totals of all Master races. There will be age group classes of 30-39, 40-49, and 50+. Helmets required. The World Championships will be awarded in each category.

Tele Festival Events

The Festival will offer fun activities for everyone of all ability levels. Activities include: a TeleWorld Bumps Contest; a 'Free Heel Fly In' to be held at the Winter Sports Park (venue for the 2002 Olympic event); Tele tours with the Powderbirds helicopter guides; and backcountry tours with Exum Guides. Special telemark clinics will be offered with the best instructors in the intermountain region. Planned social events will allow skiers and spectators to meet racers and make new friends.

Telemark Workshops

Telemark skills clinics will be held on every non-race day for participants of all skill levels. Ski jumping clinics will also be offered during the 'Free Heel Fly In' event at the Utah Winter Sports Park. All clinics feature outstanding instructors, including members of the PSIA Nordic Demonstration team. See registration form for prices.
