## **USTSA BOD Conference Call**

December 11, 2007, 7:00 MT

## Agenda:

- 1. Race Schedule Update, including European travel in January Jim / Tory
  - Eric and Shane are coordinating with team members heading to Europea. European schedule as posted on USTSA calendar is correct. So far, only Drew is planning to attend Norway events.
  - Selkirk Classic and Tamarack event are only confirmed Western events. Tory is still working on Colorado event schedule. Potential for race at Steamboat Feb 2 & 3. There will be no training in Colorado in December
  - Jim will check with Mike Foote regarding East Coast races
- 2. World Cup Race Action Items (what can we do to help?)- Jim
  - Jim has a person working with him on planning and administering the WC race in Sugarbush and Sugarbush has assigned one person to be the key contact for race organization. This is a key factor in getting things organized.
  - Jim is working on lodging arrangements for BOD that will be at the race. Russ & Linda are planning on attending. Jim will also be working on identifying where other BOD members can help during the race.
  - Jim should have a financial projection from Sugarbush soon so that we can look at their cost and revenue estimates and understand USTSA potential liability.
  - Jim has contacted Fabio from Canada to be TD for the races
- 3. Uniform / riser status
  - Uniforms are being sent back to the embroiderer to fix a problem. Jim hopes to ship them
    to racers (via Hobbs in west) by year end. We expect them to get to racers before they
    leave for Europe.
  - Tory is still working with BCA on risers for the bindings. Tory does not know when the risers will be available.
  - Scarpa is sending patches for racer uniforms.
- 4. Discuss / Approve Comp Guide Changes
  - Proposed changes were approved. These changes will be identified in italics in the new version of the guide
  - We will bind up a few copies for distribution and email the file to all racers and BOD. Christopher will post the Comp Guide on the web site when he gets the file.
  - One additional section will be added as follows:
    - 5211 Any gate within a "free" section should have yellow panels. Gates within a "free" section must be negotiated correctly or the racer will be disqualified.
       No penalties will be assessed racers within a free section, regardless of the racers turn style or if the racer falls while within the "free" section.
- 5. BOD Vote on B/Devo Team uniform cost (with / without Speedsuits).
  - Unanimous BOD vote that all B and Devo Team members be charged \$400 for their uniform (jacket, pants, fleece and speedsuit).

- 6. BOD vote on event insurance fee of \$250 and guidelines for when fee would be waived (Selkirk doesn't need our coverage, but we will list the event to protect ourselves).
  - Unanimous BOD vote that Events Director will collect \$250 fee for insurance coverage on sanctioned races in lieu of a head tax. The Events Director has the authority to negotiate discounts to the standard fee for any event.
  - All events (racing or educational) that are linked to USTSA will be listed on our corporate liability insurance policy, even if the race organizer has separate insurance.
- Review process for notifying insurance company of racing or educational events whether covered on not.
  - Unanimous BOD approval of "Request for Sanctioning and Insurance for USTSA Event" form to notify Linda Hobbs of the information needed to secure insurance coverage.
- 8. BOD vote that no charge for fund raiser liability insurance
  - Unanimous BOD approval that liability insurance for fund raisers that benefit USTSA or USTSA team members will be provided at no cost to the organizer.
- 9. Review rules for use of new waiver form
  - Waiver form needs to be filled out for all participants, volunteers and coaches at any race linked to USTSA, even if USTSA does not provide insurance for the event.
  - USTSA will need to coordinate participation during registration to ensure valid waivers are signed by all participants or legal guardians of participants if the participant is under 18 years old.
  - After the race, results and waivers should be sent to Russ & Linda Hobbs for retention with other insurance related records
- 10. BOD to confirm Scarpa will be considered as Gold sponsor.
  - BOD agreed that the value of Scarpa's donations of free and discounted equipment, the duration of their commitment and their long term commitment to USTSA qualifies them as a Gold sponsor.
  - BOD agreed that the value of BCA's donation of free equipments and the duration of their commitment qualifies them as a Gold sponsor.
- 11. BOD approved spending approximately \$200 on up to 2 sets of radios for use during races. Tory and Christopher will work on selecting the appropriate radios.
