Agenda:

1. Uniforms (Eric)

- Eric submitted a "wish list" to Karbon last week and will forward that correspondence to the BOD.
- Peter McMahon is working with a Whitefish embroiderer to help us do the embroidery at a considerably reduced cost, using team member labor.
- Peter and Eric are looking for a digitized image of a logo for the embroidery. Christopher will send them something he has.

2. Team Status (Tory)

5. Memberships (Eric, Linda)

 - 260x90 Banners at bottom of page can read "Banners for Sanctioned Races will be placed here". – Christopher
 - o Include link to Trond's website on points page in text regarding FIS points Linda
 - Write some current articles: 2009 Team, WC schedule, Telemark Skier Partnership, US Races? - Linda

• The Following are longer term items which were discussed (Note that Christopher, Russ and Linda have additional items that were not discussed)

- Sanctioned Race Banners Linda will document banner requirements to include in the Race Organizer Package
- USTSA News Letter Linda will coordinate. Christopher recommends using "Constant Contact" as the vehicle for the newsletter. Put the introductory parts of articles in the newsletter with a link to read more, which takes the reader to our website.
- Results and Points from prior years are not all loaded yet. Linda will continue to work on this.
- Results Tory would love to have as many old results as possible posted. He has some sources and will continue to work on getting that information. Russ will work to post any information we receive from any source. We will also encourage racers to put the most complete results possible on their Biographies.
- Flickr Photos we need to label all the photos in Flickr. Tory suggests
 recruiting/delegating to team members. Let's ask for volunteers at 1st Team phone call.
 Linda will write instructions for what we need them to do. By labeling these photos, we
 increase our hits when people search on Google.

- U-Tube Christopher will write instructions for uploading to U-Tube. He will give Tory a lesson by phone.
- If team members or board members have information they want included on the site and don't know how to do it, Linda will be the point of contact. If she cannot do it herself, she will contact Christopher.
- The goal for this season is to get Team members to submit their Biographies and write articles for their blog on the site. In addition, we will have instructions for Team Members and Board Members to submit news articles on the site.
